Chairmans Report - Rhys Yeomans. May 2024

Sponsorship of Junior Go Kart league at Le Mans

Rocco Spinley (MX5 Club member and very competitive khanacross Junior) approached me early this year with an opportunity for the Club to sponsor a Junior go kart league at Le Mans he is involved in. This league is seen by both the competitors and organisers as a stepping point for juniors to develop their skills before moving into more competitive go karting or into Motorsport.

Following further discussions with Le Mans, Gippsland Car Club has agreed to sponsor a Gippsland Car Club membership, a Junior Speed Motorsport Australia Licence and entry to one of our khanacross events. I'm working through the finer details of the prizes with Le Mans currently, whether we sponsor one whole round or individual prizes over multiple rounds.

The benefit to the Club will be new Junior members who will hopefully remain members of our Club and compete in our events and become active within our Club. While the benefit for the winner of the prize will be the ability to enter our events and any other Speed events they choose, which might be their first step into none go kart Motorsport.

While Rocco is not a member of our Club, he has been a great supporter of our events and Club, and is now racing Formula Vee. When he first arrived at Bryant Park two or so years ago, he was very new to driving and it has been great to see his development. I appreciate him seeing the benefit in introducing us to Le Mans and I hope this can be a successful relationship for all parties involved.

Guttering on the rear of the pit garages

A quote from Nuggies Roofing & Plumbing to repair the guttering on the rear of the pit garages, which has been in a state of disrepair for longer than I'd like to admit. The existing guttering will be remounted and additional downpipes will be added and connected to stormwater pipe that will run the length of the pit garages before joining the existing stormwater point. I'm aiming to have this work completed before VHC RD4, which I'll confirm with Nuggies by the time you read this. There is a list of maintenance items we're working through and I'll be glad to tick this one off.

Wednesday working bees

A reminder that Bill Jennings and Ian Mayze are at Bryant Park most Wednesdays completing grass cutting and other maintenance work. All members are welcome to attend and contribute, especially if you aren't burdened to attend work on a Wednesday like some of us! If you are interested in attending on Wednesdays, please contact Bill (0459833431) or Ian (0409760314). Once the new building is up and running, there are plans to turn the current scrutineering area into a workshop. We have plenty of storage at Bryant Park, but indoor working space is extremely limited.

2024 Australian Hill Climb Championships - Update

I thought I would provide an update of where we are currently with the coming AHCC in October.

- Sponsors We have secured 1 Silver sponsor and a number of class sponsors, however we
 are still a long way away from what we need in order for this event to be financially viable.
 The biggest thing we need is a naming rights sponsor. I have spoken to a few parties on this
 topic but we still haven't secured one. We want to be able to provide a significant amount
 of prize money for this event, however this will need to be cut back if we can't afford it.
- Government Grant I have applied for a \$20k grant from the Victorian Government to support significant sporting events. The submission has been completed and I have gone back on a couple of rounds of questions. As it sits now I am still awaiting a final response from them.
- Food Van/s Rhys has been in the process of organising a coffee and a food van to supplement our own canteen operation over the weekend.
- Volunteers This is still a major issue and we desperately need someone to coordinate the
 volunteers for the event. This is not a super complex task, however it is one that requires
 someone to spend the planning time to ensure we have people in the right places at all
 times.
- Emergency Services and Permits These things are in hand with Fire & Rescue and Ambulance services booked. The permits are in the process of being done, the only thing is that these are expensive parts of the plan and we need more sponsors!
- Bryant Park preparation plan I have started some work on the parking and trailer parking plans. One thing is for sure, we can't allow what we have seen at the recent Victorian Rounds with trailers everywhere in the pits. There will be dedicated trailer parking areas in the grassed paddock behind our pits and in the area behind the pit sheds. All trailers will need to be parked in these areas and we will also not be allowing tender vehicles parked in the pits. Beyond this there will need to be a lot of other minor jobs completed like line marking and general working bee items before we can hold the event.
- Timing We will be testing our new timing system over the next few Hill Climbs in order to iron out any bugs. All things being equal we will run the new timing system for the AHCC with at least 1 (but possibly 2) split times as well as the overall time.
- Toilets and Showers I have booked portable toilets to be placed over in the spectator parking area as well as an additional shower which will be placed near the clubrooms. With these and our existing facilities and the new building running we are covered for what we need and all areas of the facility will have toilets close by.

I still need help from people to make this event a reality. Ideally it needs to be people outside of the current board who already have a number of things to work on. If you can help in any way please reach out to me.

VICTORIAN HILL CLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND 4, APRIL 21 (images by Seven70 Photography)

There were 92 competitors contesting this event, which was run by the Phillip Island Auto Racing Club (PIARC) at our track on April 21 – all competitors were given the opportunity of having four runs each, with the day finishing just before 4 pm. in the afternoon. The event, as well as being a round of the Victorian Hill Climb Championship, was also a round of the Gippsland Car Club Championship, and as such over 30 of the entrants were GCC members.



Nine of the first ten outright were GCC members. Fastest time of day, with a best time of 53.01 seconds was our South Australian member Dave Mahon in his Dallara. Second outright was Mike Barker in his Hayward with a time of 53.55, a mere 0.54 of a second behind Dave. Ewen Moile finished in third position in his Ramblebee Mark 8 with a time of 56.84 seconds. Matthew Healy was in fourth position in his Yacar Crosskart, with a time of 56.88. a fraction behind Ewen. Pete Minahan was in position number 5 in the Hayward with a best of 58.73, Keith Wilson was in position 6 in the Ninja BH (Brett Haywards first car!) with a time of 60.55, then came Steve Buffinton in the first sports car (Westfield) with a time of 61.62. Zachary Hanlin in the first tin top (BMW M140i) with a time of 62.20, then James Dyer in the Toyota GR Yaris in 62.57 seconds, and rounding out the Top 10 Jordan James with a best time of 62.60, a whisker behind James.

Scott Slater took out the Formula Vee class by less than a second from Bill Roberts, whilst Dave Mahon was a convincing winner in the Formula Libre up to 1600 class. Mike Barker was the only entrant in the FL 1301 to 2000 class. Steve Buffinton finished over two seconds in front of Dale Hocking in the Clubman Sports Car class, whilst Sei Vella took out the Sports Cars Open/Closed up to 2000 from eleven other competitors! Casey Pilcher was successful in the Spots Cars Open/Closed 2001 to 3000. Ian Speight finished on top of the pile in the Sports Cars 2A & 2B up to 2000, with Lasith Lyanage not managing to finish the day when he had a hefty swipe against the concrete wall,

setting off all of his air bags. Hugh Feggans was the only starter in the 2A & 2F class 2001 to 3000, whilst John Trolove scraped in in front of James McNiven in the 2A & 2F class 3001 and over by a mere 0.27 of a second.



David Cantwell was successful in the Sports Sedans up to 1600 class, Stuart Haverkort was first in the SS 1601 to 2000 class, Chris Harwood took out first in the SS 2001 and over class, whilst James Dyer won the SS 4WD class by 0.03 of a second from Jordan James. The Improved Production classes were well subscribed, with Rhys Yeomans winning the IP up to 1600 class with a best time of 62.76 seconds, from Warren Heath a mere 0.18 of a second behind with a time of 62.94 seconds. Ayrton Williams was first in the IP up to 2000 class, Karl Hess was the winner of the IP 2001 to 3000 class from the hard charging Terry Selwyn in second. Zachary Hanlin was successful in the IP 3001 and over class, whilst Brian Portz was first past the post in the IP 4WD class. James Lambert gave the beautiful Elfin Mono a run to taste success in the Historic Other class, whilst Steven Weymouth-Wilson finished in front of his father Peter in the Historic Group N up to 2000 class.





Three rounds of the 2024 VHCC have now been conducted, with three to go. The next scheduled event is Round 5 to be held at Rob Roy on May 19, to be followed by Round 3 (postponed from March) at Mt Leura, Camperdown on June 1 and 2, – (PLEASE NOTE: This event will now not be held – see elsewhere in this Valve Bounce for an explanation), and Round 6 at One Tree Hill, Ararat, on August 10 and 11. The One Tree Hill event is for tin tops only. Results for Round 4 are included elsewhere in this Valve Bounce.

CLUB PERMITS Many members have Club Permits for their vehicles, and many of them wait until it is the proverbial five minutes before payment is due to send the permit to the Club for signing. It might take up until a week for your Club Permit to be collected from the Post Office Box, so if you intend to send it to the PO Box, send it sometime before payment is due. A much better idea for Club Permit holders is to send the permit directly to Ken Neilson – his name and address is on the list of Board members on Page 2 of every Valve Bounce. If you use this method, the Permit will most likely be returned to you much faster than if you send it to the PO Box. Please remember when you are sending your permit in for signature to include a stamped self-addressed envelope for the return of the Permit.

WORKING BEES AND MEMBERS PRACTICE DAYS Club members are eligible to practice at the track on Working Bee days (provided they have done some work in the mornings) and also on the Saturday prior to competition days on Sundays. At this point in time, days when practice can be undertaken are as follows (more working bees will be inserted into the Calendar as the year progresses):

AUSTRALIAN HILL CLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP 2024 Jarrod Bryant is working away on this event with little assistance at this time from other members. Jarrod has raised some sponsorship, but nothing like we need for the event. The AHCC is a very expensive event to run, and the Club will make a loss on the event if we are not able to raise the funding necessary. If you can assist Jarrod, please contact him with your offers of help — some members have done so, but many more are needed to assist. The AHCC is a four day event, not the usual one of two day shows that we normally run. The timetable for the event is:

Thursday, October 24 Untimed, unofficial practice

Friday, October 25 Official practice – all entrants expected to practice

Saturday, October 26 Official time runs – four on the day

Sunday, October 27 Official timed runs – three on the day, to be followed by

MONEY One of my jobs on the Board is that of Treasurer, i.e. the person who looks after the money. This involves keeping an overview of income and expenditure, and having monthly statements published for the Board. We employ Meg Paulet to do the monthly statements, and these are presented by me to the Board at the monthly Board meeting. There are many people, usually from other Clubs but often our own members, who believe that our Club is very affluent because all of our assets are somewhat better than those of most other Clubs. Nineteen years ago, we were told by Tru Energy that they were taking over our old hill climb track, Gippsland Park, in Latrobe Road Morwell, and for us not to bother spending any more money on our property – I found this out when I went to Tru Energy cap in hand to try and gain sponsorship for the 2004 Australian Hill Climb Championship. I gained the sponsorship but our track deteriorated in the next few years whilst we contemplated the future. The long and the short of it was that we finished up with a new track at very little cost to our Club – I spent the best part of three years working with Tru Energy finding a site and then planning our new track, which opened on July 6, 2008. We spent all of our available

money at the time on barriers and timing equipment. We had portable toilets, and our timing was done in a caravan. Tru Energy gave us money to construct our Club Rooms and toilets to replace those we had at Gippsland Park – many working bees went into the construction of the building, designed by Wayne Mercer. We upgraded our timing location from a caravan to an Atco hut, cost nothing, but come and get it from the bottom of the Yallourn Mine. The building was in filthy condition, but it did us until we were able to buy our new building about three years ago - we paid the complete cost of the new building. The block of 15 garages was constructed and paid for by David Anderson and Glenn Campbell, with all income going to them – the agreement was that after ten years the ownership would revert to the Club, which it did about three years ago. The new track was very popular, and we had many track hires, so made much more money than we had at the old track. The Board made a decision early on that we would invest a minimum of \$20,000 per year in an investment account to cover the cost of track resurfacing when required. This was required after ten years, and we had the money to do it – we still do the same thing and have an amount of money in the investment account which will cover the next resurfacing, even though we now earn less income as we have less hires. Our current new toilet/scrutineering building is costing a lot of money, but most of it has been obtained from a Government grant, the application for which was prepared by Ian Maud. We have to pay a sizeable amount to complete the building, but judicious financial management has ensured that we have this money in hand. Some might say we are lucky in that we have obtained many of our assets, including the track, at a very low price, certainly much lower than it would have been if the Club had to pay for everything. This does not mean that if we need anything else at the track, it will not cost much - what it means is that a very small number of people do a huge amount of work to ensure that we are able to make the most of any grants if they become available. We have reached the time in our Club that some of our assets need repairs/restructure etc - maybe this is where you can help as much of this work can be done at our ongoing working bees.


MOTORSPORT AUSTRALIA AND MONEY It was recently announced that MA had made a loss of over \$1 million for the year ended December 31, 2023 – the loss for the previous year was roughly \$288,000, thus an increase of approximately three quarters of a million dollars. The main areas where the loss had increased were insurances and event promotional expenses. Members will be aware that the cost of competition licences and the cost of running events has increased, particularly last year, and it would not be hard to guess that MA will further increase the cost of running events and the cost of competition licences in the near future. The cost of running events impacts on the Club as the cost of permits will increase – we will probably have no option but to increase entry costs. Do you know how much it costs to run our events? The cost of an MA permit for a multiclub event is approximately \$1,000, ambulance \$2,000, safety vehicle \$750 and trophies \$500 - \$4,250. At an entry cost of \$110 (\$10 of which is GST) we make \$100 per entry, thus we need just over 40 entries to break even – we run a very borderline financial business model, and basically only make money from track hires.

CANTEEN As those who have been at the track in recent times are aware, our Canteen is again up and running. Many thanks to Julie Barker who volunteered to manage the canteen and who works very hard on competition days in the Canteen. Thanks also go to Lee Selwyn, Marilyn Wilson, Ian Maud and Mark Berryman who have volunteered to work in the Canteen at recent events. The Canteen is another place where members can volunteer to assist, and this helps both Julie and the Club as the Canteen is an income earner for the Club. As we are running the AHCC in late October, it would be great to see some offers of assistance to help in the canteen during this event. The canteen will be a busy and tiring place over these four days and your offers of help would be much appreciated.

Round 4 of the Victorian Khanacross Championship, which was also a round of our Club Khanacross Championship, was held on Sunday, April 28 – started off as a cool and cloudy day but became warm and sunny as the day progressed, and all in attendance appeared to have a good day, except for one who had an off track excursion.

Rob Duncan set out eight courses in his usual meticulous manner and all entrants completed the courses and had set off for home just after 2.30 p.m. We had 31 competitors attack the courses, which is a few less than normal, mainly due, I believe, to the fact that the headline was Victorian Championship rather than Gippsland Car Club. Only nine of our Club members competed, with the other twenty two coming from all over the place – I assume that they are the regular competitors in the State Championship.



The winner on the day was Barry Nowell from the Geelong Motorsports Club driving his Baztec – a classic motorkhana/khanacross special, being a buggy with Barry sitting on the left had side of the car and a motorcycle engine sitting next to him on the right hand side of the car. Barry completed all runs without any penalties, and recorded 356.14 seconds for the eight runs. In second place was new GCC member Simon Wills, who recorded 369.27 seconds in his Mazda MX5, which included one five second penalty for going outside the boundary of the course on one run. Jeffery Salmon from the Toyota Club was third in his Subaru WRX just 0.17 seconds behind Simon. In fourth place was Matthew Webb from the Victorian Mini Club driving his Mini, next in fifth came Adam Pass from the Ford Four Club in his Fiesta, in sixth was another new GCC member Rod Macnab in a Mazda MX5, seventh was GCC member David French in the Toyota Corona, eighth was Nicholas Charrett from

Ford Four in a Fiesta, ninth was Scott Seddon from GCC in a VW Golf, and in tenth place Rocco Spinley from PIARC in a Mazda MX5. Six juniors competed on the day, which is good – three of them were from our Club – Aston Hill, Sarah Seddon and Caitlin Seddon.




